CELLAR

CHARDONNAY | Domaine Daniel - Etienne Defaix

\$22 (3oz) / \$36 (5oz)

*Chablis, 1er Cru "Les Lys"**Burgundy, FR '03*

Daniel-Etienne Defaix's ancestors were already cultivating the vine in the sixteenth century at the Château de Faix near Avallon, not far from Chablis. Etienne-Paul Defaix installed the family as vigneron in Chablis during the eighteenth century. Today, Daniel-Etienne Defaix continues this long family tradition as he maintains a domaine of 26 hectares planted exclusively to Chardonnay and primarily in a series of vineyard sites classified 1er Cru.

The Domaine Daniel-Etienne Defaix releases its wine to the market only after obtaining several years of bottle age at which point the market has the pleasure of having access to wines that more fully express the remarkable and unique terroir that is Chablis.

PINOT NOIR | Domaine Lucien Boillot et Fils

*Gevrey-Chambertin, 1er Cru "Les Corbeaux",**Côtes de Nuits, Burgundy, FR '14*

Pierre Boillot is a rare master of both the Côtes de Beaune and the Côtes de Nuits—not only does he have the vineyards but also the savoir-faire and skill. Pierre inherited this domaine from his father Lucien, whose name it still carries. Pierre worked together with his brother Louis for years, but a few years ago they parted ways and split up the family holdings. Pierre's talent has become much more evident as he has had full control over this domaine, and in addition to retaining the original cellars in Gevrey-Chambertin, Pierre has instituted a rigorous revitalizing of the soils and vines in all of his vineyards.

The vines in the Les Corbeaux vineyard were planted in 1960.

TEMPRANILLO | Muga Prado Enea, Gran Reserva

Bodegas Muga is located in the historical Barrio de La Estación (railway station district) in Haro. The facilities are two centuries old, built mainly of stone and oak. Tempranillo is considered to have its origins in the area of La Rioja. It is the most prestigious Spanish variety because of its quality potential. Following traditional methods, Bodegas Muga uses oak throughout all the wine-making process, fermentation and ageing. As a matter of fact, Bodegas Muga is one of the very few Spanish wineries that employ three coopers plus a "cubero" (who specializes in the big casks). They are in charge of working with the oak wood that will finally give that unique and personal touch to the wines. Gran Reserva Rioja wines have been aged for at least two years in cask and three years in the bottle.

SYRAH | Louis Barruol

*Côtes Rôtie, "La Boisselée"**Rhône Valley, FR '12*

Louis Barruol is an indefatigable force in the Rhône. He is the fourteenth generation in his family to be making wine in this sixteenth-century domaine in Gigondas. On what was once the site of a Roman villa, Louis' cellars show spectacular remains of old, Roman vinification vats carved into the limestone. Here, Louis works with different grape varietals from the Rhône, vinifying each parcel separately. He has recently taken to acting as a micro-négociant, working closely with top growers in the northern part of the region who still work with Sérine, an ancient version of Syrah. Producing only a few precious barrels of each cuvée, Louis is helping to save the authenticity and the identity of many great old Côte Rôtie parcels, and now those of Hermitage and Crozes, by keeping them out of the hands of the large, corporate négociants in the area. Côte Rôtie translates to "roasted slope" in English, referring to the steep, hot slopes in the Northern Rhône Valley - perfect for Syrah.

Chenin Blanc

Chenin Blanc is a bit of a chameleon – as it has the potential to have many different personalities and styles. In the right hands, the wine can be produced to be light and vibrantly bone dry; yet by another producer, the wine can be rich, textured and sometimes sweet. Famed from the Loire Valley in France and small regions such as Montlouis, Vouvray, and Jasnières, Chenin Blanc truly stands on its pedestal and takes its place among the world's great white wines.

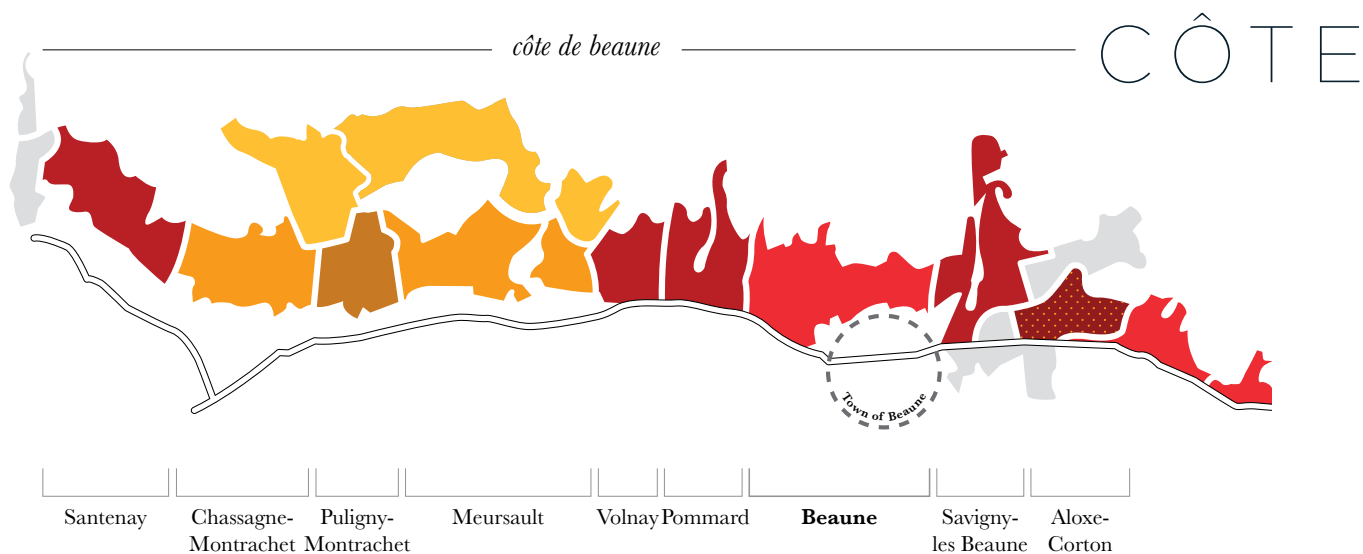

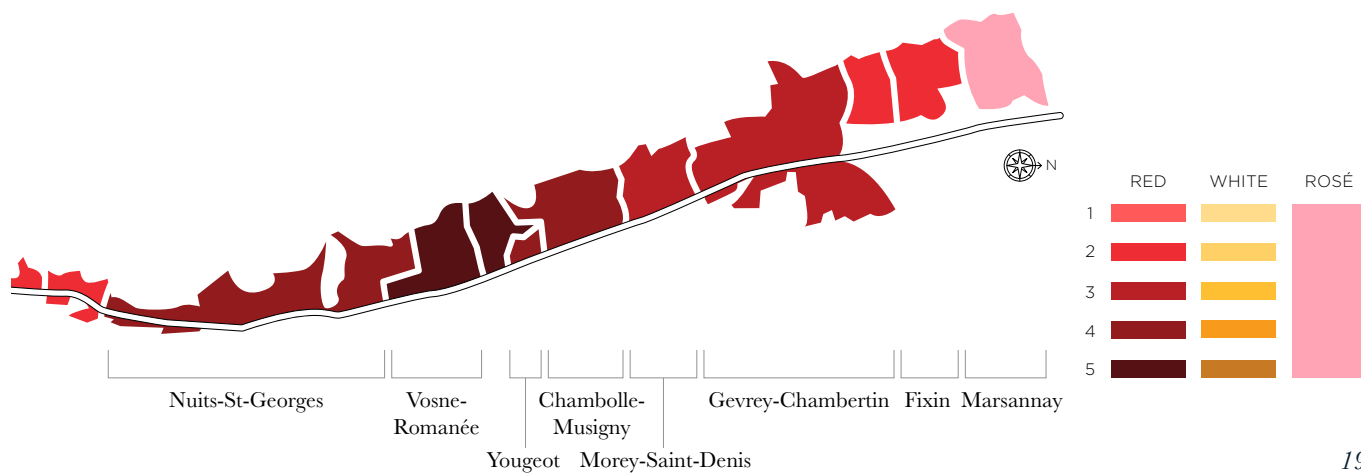

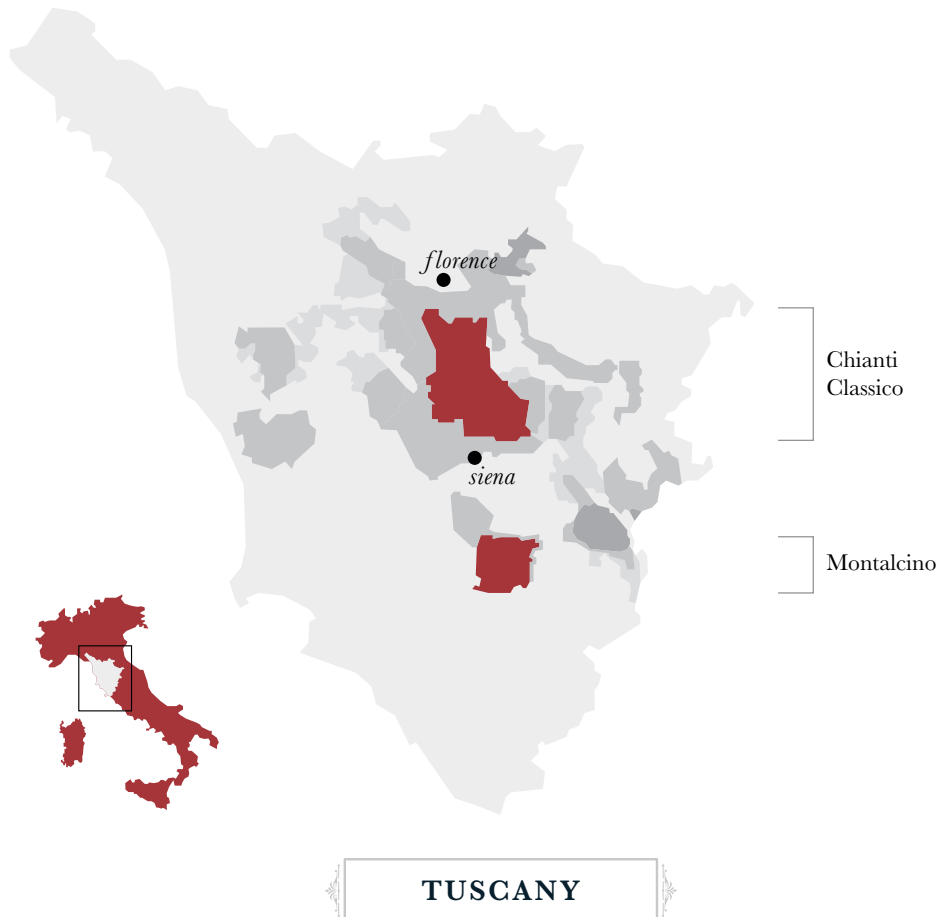
